

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

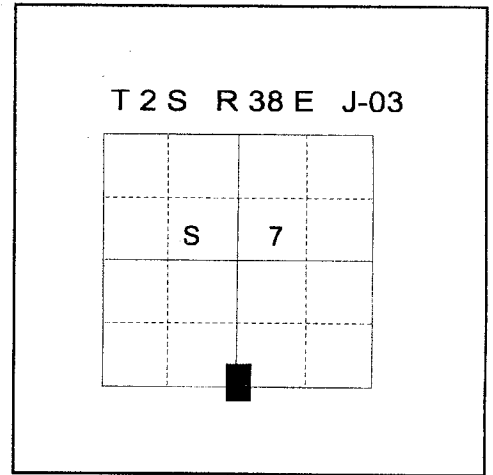
Corner originally established by Herman D. Gradon under GLO contract Number 452, dated March 31, 1882. Surveyor General record states:

Set 3 foot long 3 inch square wooden post 24 inches in the ground for 1/4 corner, from which; A 10 inch Fir marked 1/4 S BT, which bears North 30° West 7 links.

A 12 inch Fir marked 1/4 S BT, which bears South 30° West 14 links.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

No original evidence found

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position established by Survey number 023-2001, I set a 2 1/2"x 30" aluminum monument marked as shown, 27 inches in the ground, from which;

NEW BEARING TREES:

A 13 inch White Fir bears North 55° West, a distance of 33.60 feet, marked X BT.

A 15 inch White Fir bears South 3° East, a distance of 36.20 feet, marked 1/4 S18 BT.

A 20 inch Douglas Fir bears South 27° west, a distance of 55.10 feet, marked 1/4 S18 BT.

A 23 inch White Fir bears North 63° west, a distance of 43.90 feet, marked 1/4 S7 BT.

Set steel fence post approximately 1 foot North of monument.


Raised a mound of stone around monument, 1 ft. base to top of cap.
