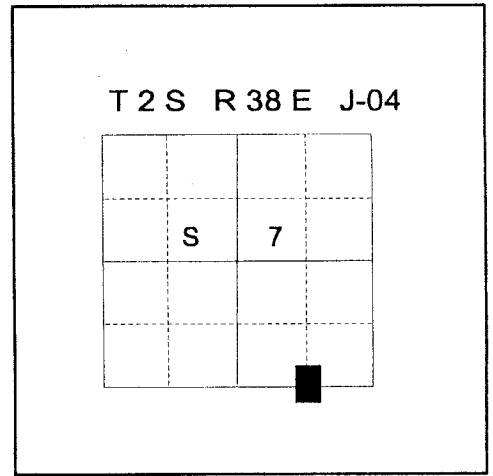


**CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION**

**HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:**

No original corner established.



**DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:**

See Survey Number 23-2001

**DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:**

At the position established by Survey number 23-2001, I set a 5/8"x 30" iron pin with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown, 30 inches in the ground, from which;

**NEW BEARING TREES AND OBJECT:**

A 29 inch Ponderosa Pine bears South 46° East, a distance of 32.99 feet, marked 1/16 S18 BT.

A 15 inch Douglas Fir bears South 85° West, a distance of 39.90 feet, marked 1/16 S18 BT.

Set steel fence post approximately 1 foot West of monument.
