
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

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## History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established by Henry Meldrum, Deputy Surveyor, under Contract No. 450, dated June 11, 1882.
Surveyors General's notes state: "Set post, 3 ft, long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec., cor., mkd. 1/4 on N. face; from shich; A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears SO4°E, 38 lks. diat. mkd. 1/4S BT. A fir 15" diam., bears NO2°W, 14 lks. dist. mkd. 1/4S BT."



## Description of corner evidence found:

Found no trace of record post. Found 38" white fir, barked scribed 1/4S BT. Measured NO4°W, 25.1 ft. from which a rotten stump is NO2°W, 9,2 ft.

## Description of manument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the above point set 2 1/2" X 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 24" in the ground. No rock in the area.

From which by magnetic declination of N20°E;

An 11" tamarac bears N16°E, 27.0 ft, scribed 1/4835 BT. 1980

A 9" white fir bears S 50°E, 5.3 ft, scribed 1/482 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s, 54-4s and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on BT.s Placed 54-2 and 54-4 on steel fence post 5" west of the corner.
