

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with 2 ½" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 30 inches in the ground, from which:


A 14 inch White Fir bears North 1° East, a distance of 19.35 feet, marked N1/16 S6 BT. An 8 inch White Fir bears South  $78^\circ$  West, a distance of 5.45 feet, marked N1/16 S1 BT.

I set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot East of the corner monument. I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on October 9, 2013.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 16° East declination. The distances are to a 60d spike in the right hand side of the root crown of the new bearing trees. Bearings are to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the lower BT blaze.
