DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found a 2" iron pipe 5 1/2 ft. above ground, in a collar of stone 3 ft. diam., from which:

A 30 inch pine snag bears South 82° East, a distance of 157.2 feet, with scribe marks visible on an opened blaze.

A 28 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North 67° West, a distance of 163.4 feet, alive and vigorous with scribe marks visible on an opened blaze.

From the 2" iron pipe position, I take new bearing trees:

An 18 inch Ponderosa Pine bears South 66° West, a distance of 105.90 feet, marked 1/4 S1 BT.
