
History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract No.450 and dated June 11, 1882.

Surveyor General records state:


Set post 3 ft long 3 in square 24 in in ground for 1/4 Sec.Cor. marked 1/4 S on W face from which:

A tamarack 2.6 in diam bears $N57^{\circ}E$, 5.0 lks dist marked 1/4S BT. A fir 2.6 in diam bears $N87^{\circ}W$, 68 lks dist marked 1/4S BT.



Description of corner evidence found:

Searched 6 man-hours on 6-30-88 and 7-06-88 for original corner and accessories on steep north mountainside - several rotten stumps and evidence of old wildfire, corner declared



Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At proportioned position between controlling Section Corners North and South...

Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 24" in ground & 6" projecting out of ground with surrounding rock mound & 6' fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: A white fir 16" diam brs $N60^{\circ}W$, 19.6' dist mkd 1/4S4 BT. A white fir 19" diam brs $N39^{\circ}E$, 22.0' dist mkd 1/4S3 BT.

New BT's have a brass washer stamped PLS 1639 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 and painted face of blaze and 6" band of red around each BT.

Compass declination 190 East.
