
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract No. 450 and dated June 11, 1882. Surveyor General records state: Set a 4' long 4" square post 24" in ground for Cor to Secs 1, 12, 6 & 7 marked T2SS1 on Nw, R40ES12 on SW, R41ES7 on SE and S6 on NE with 5 notches on S and 1 on N edges from which: A 6" fir brs N80 E, 20 1ks dist mkd S6 BT. A 9" pine brs N45 W, 1 1ks dist mkd T2SS1 BT. A 10" pine brs S57 W, 21 1ks dist mkd R40ES12 BT. A 7" pine brs S45 E, 11 1ks dist mkd R41ES7 BT.



Corner MODIFIED by Alonzo Gesner under GLO contrace No. 683 and dated June 07, 1898, and his record states: Cor to Secs 1 and 12 which is a post marked and witnessed as stated by the U.S. Surveyor General and I added T2S on the NW face of post and obliterated the marks on the NE & SE faces. Also obliterated marks on the bearing trees in Secs 6 & 7.

Found rotten and burned remains of post to depth of 20" from which:

A spruce 12" dia brs  $\rm N82^{O}E$ , 14.3'(record, fir brs  $\rm N80^{O}E$ , 20 lks) with axe marks on partially healed blaze. A L.P. pine leaning snag 6" dia brs  $\rm N31^{O}W$ , 2.8'(record,  $\rm N45^{O}W$ , 1 lk) marked "T2" on rotting blaze.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of found original post...

Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 25" in ground with 5" projecting out of ground with surrounding rock mound and 6' fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: A spruce ll" diam brs N52 $\frac{1}{2}^{O}$ W, 10.1' dist mkd T2SR40ES1 BT. W. fir ll" diam brs S58 $\frac{1}{2}^{O}$ W, 35.4' dist mkd T2SR40ES12 BT.

Each BT has a sign 54-3 and signs 54-4 or 54-9 attached below a 6 "band of red paint, and each new BT has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.

Compass declination 190 East.
