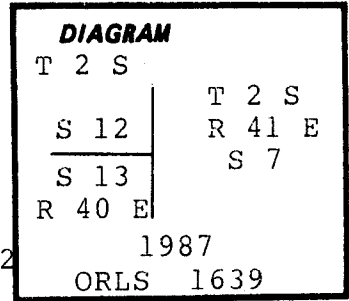


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

J-25

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract No. 450 and dated June 11, 1882. Surveyor General records state: A pine post 4' long 4" square 24" in ground for Cor to Secs 12,13,7 & 18 mkd T2SR40ES12 on NW, R40ES13 on SW, R41ES18 on SE and S7 on NE with 4 notches on S and 2 on N edges from which: A 16" pine brs N27°E, 32 lks mkd S7 BT. A 10" fir brs N38°W, 25 lks mkd T2SS12 BT. A 8" fir brs S62°W, 4 lks mkd R40ES13 BT. A 7" fir brs S78°E, 62 lks mkd R41ES18 BT.



Corner MODIFIED by Alonzo Gesner under contract No.683 and dated June 07, 1898, and his records state: Found original post marked and witnessed as stated by the U.S. Surveyor General. I obliterated marks on the NE and SE faces of post, also obliterated marks on the bearing trees in Secs 7 and 18. I marked the NW face of post T 2 S.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a rotten and burned remains of wood post from which:
 A spruce 20" dia brs N40°W, 15.6'(record, N38°W, 25 lks) with healed blaze.
 A rotten pine windblow & root stub brs N27°E, 17.5'(record, 32 lks) with visible axe work on rotten blaze.
 A rotten fir windblow & root stub brs S78°E, 41.4'(record, 62 lks) with visible axe work on rotten blaze.
 A rotten fir windblow & root hole brs S42°W, 3.8'(record, S62°W, 4 lks) no marks identified.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of found original post...
 Set 2½" aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 25" in ground with 5" projecting out of ground with surrounding rock mound and 6' fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.
 New bearing tree established:
 A spruce 13" diam brs S74°W, 31.3' dist mkd T2SR40ES13 BT.
 Each BT has a sign 54-3 and signs 54-4 or 54-9 attached below a 6" band of red paint, and each new BT has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.
 Compass declination 19° East.
