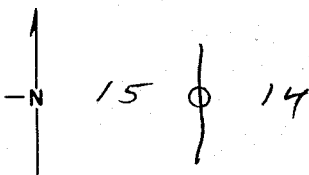

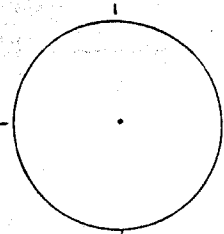

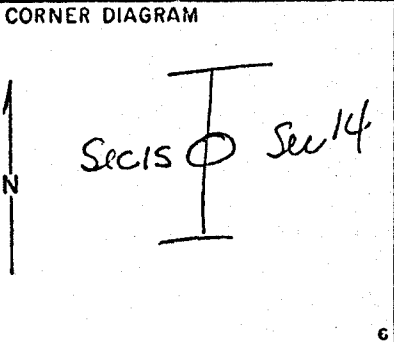

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

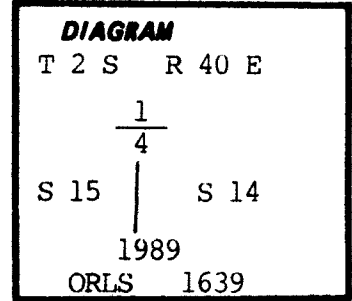

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Henry Meldrum under GLO Contract no. 450 dated June 11, 1882, and his record states:

A post 3 ft long 3 ins square 24 ins in ground for 1/4 Sec. Corner marked 1/4 S on W face, from which:

A tamarack 20 ins diam bears N9°E, 21 lks dist marked 1/4 S BT.
A fir 14 ins diam bears S9°W, 35 lks dist marked 1/4 S BT.



Description of corner evidence found:

None. Corner reestablished by proportionate measurement from survey control.

Corner search area is on steep north slope forested predominantly with large western larch and fir - also several large completely rotten stumps - extensive search with increment bore and chain saw did not result in any corner evidence. Found a location tag placed by JRM on 23" diam western larch indicating approximate search area - also found a dead 7" diam lodgepole pine blazed on four sides.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position midway between adjacent section corners north and south...

Set a 2" x 30" aluminum pipe with 2½" aluminum cap 24" in ground & projecting 6" out of ground with surrounding stone mound & placed 6' steel fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established:

Spruce 7" dia brs S33½°W, 4.4' dist mkd 1/4 S15 BT.
Spruce 16" dia brs S65½°E, 19.0' dist mkd 1/4 S14 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 & painted face of blaze & a 6' band of red around each bearing tree.

Compass declination 19° East.

I hereby certify that the above described corner monument was properly established by me & witnessed by F.S. Munro on October 02, 1989.
