

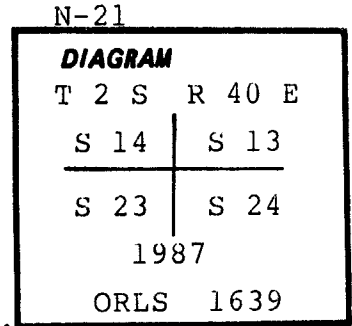
**CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION**

**History of original corner establishment:**

Corner established by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract No. 450 and dated June 11, 1882.

Surveyor General records state:

Basalt stone 18 x 10 x 7 ins, 12 ins in ground for Cor to Secs 13, 14, 23 & 24, marked with 3 notches on S and 1 on E edge on top of hill from which:  
 A pine 26" dia brs N12°W, 66 lks dist mkd R40ES14 BT.  
 A pine 15" dia brs S51°W, 86 lks dist mkd S23 BT.  
 A pine 26" dia brs S56°E, 86 lks dist mkd S24 BT.  
 A pine 6" dia brs N07°E, 62 lks dist mkd T2SS13 BT.



**Description of corner evidence found:**

A stone 20 x 10 x 7" (record, 18 x 10 x 7") in place on surface marked with 3 notches on the S face and 5 notches on the W face (record, 1 notch on E face) from which:

Rotten pine log 24" dia brs S51°W, 66 lks dist per record, no marks identified. Rotten pine log 24" dia brs S51°W, 86 lks dist per record, no marks. Pine log 20" dia brs S56°E, 86 lks dist per record with "S24 BT" scribes visible in chopped open double blaze. No trace of section 13 BT.

**Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:**

At position of found stone...

Set 2½" aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 25" in ground & 5" projecting out of ground with surrounding rock mound & 6' fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Buried stone alongside.

New bearing trees established:

- A 18" LP pine brs N48°E, 45.1' mkd T2SR40ES13 BT.
- A 18" LP pine brs S25°E, 52.0' mkd T2SR40ES24 BT.
- A 15" LP pine brs S42°W, 45.0' mkd T2SR40ES23 BT.
- A 15" LP pine brs N49°W, 36.3' mkd T2SR40ES14 BT.

New BT's have a brass washer stamped PLS 1639 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 and painted face of blaze and 6" band of red around each BT. Set 6' steel fence post alongside of corner and attached sign 54-9.

Compass declination 17° East.

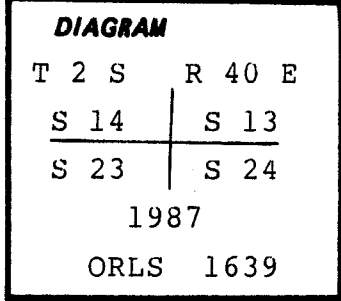
