
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally ESTABLISHED by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract No.450, dated June 11,1882.

Surveyor General records state: Set post 4 ft long 4 in square 24 in in ground for Cor to Secs 13,24,18 & 19 marked T2SR40ES13 on NW, R40ES24 on SW, S19 on SE and R41ES18 on NE with 3 notches on S and N edges, from which: A fir 6 in diam brs N53°E, 16 lks dist mkd R41ES18 BT. A fir 20 in diam brs N46°W, 19 lks dist mkd T2SR40ES13 BT. A fir 16 in diam brs S77°W, 20 lks dist mkd T24 BT. A fir 14 in diam brs S15°E, 4 lks dist mkd S19 BT.



WHON COMMY RUINTER

Corner MODIFIED by Alonzo Gesner under GLO contract No.683, dated June 7,1898, during his resurvey of the east boundary of T2SR40E,WM...The Cor to Secs 13 & 24 which is a post 3 ft above ground 2 in square mkd & witnessed as stated by U.S.Surveyor General. I obliterated marks on the NE and SE faces of post and marked the NW face T2S. Destroyed marks on the bearing trees to Secs 18 and 19.

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found burned and rotten wood to a depth of 18" for original corner post.

A white fir 30" dia mkd "13" inside healed blaze with 6" overgrowth opened this date brs  $N46^{\circ}W$ , 19 lks dist per record from corner post remains. A white fir 20" dia with fully healed blaze brs  $S77^{\circ}W$ , 20 lks dist per record from corner post remains. No trace of other two original BTs obliterated by Alonzo Gesner in 1898.

## Description of manument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of original wood post remains...

Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on 2"x 30" aluminum pipe 24" in ground to bedrock & surrounded with mound of earth & stone. Set 6' steel fence post alongside corner with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing tree established: A white fir 19" diam brs N22 $\frac{1}{2}$ OW, 27.9' dist mkd T2SR40ES13 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1639 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs  $54-3\ \&\ 54-9$  and painted face of blaze and 6" band of red around each BT.

Compass declination 190 East.
