

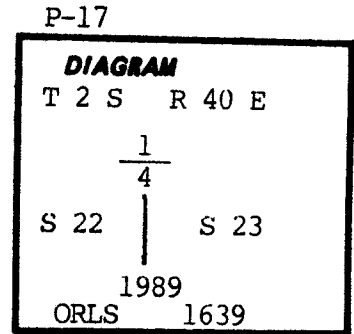
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Henry Meldrum under GLO Contract no. 450 dated June 11, 1882, and his record states:

A post 3 ft long 3 ins square 24 ins in ground for 1/4 Sec. Cor marked 1/4 S on W face, from which:

A pine 18 in diam bears N89°W, 224 lks dist marked 1/4 S BT.
A pine 18 in diam bears S85°E, 100 lks dist marked 1/4 S BT.



Description of corner evidence found:

None. Corner reestablished by proportionate measurement from survey control.

Corner search area is in area of old wildfire and dense alder brush and recent logging activity - no trees older than 30 years.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position midway between adjacent section corners north and south...

Set a 2" x 30" aluminum pipe with 2 1/2" aluminum cap 24" in ground & projecting 6" out of ground with surrounding earth mound & placed 6' steel fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. No stones available for mound.

New bearing trees established:

White fir 8" dia brs S75 1/2°E, 27.2' dist mkd 1/4 S23 BT.
Lodgepole pine 6" dia brs S30 1/2°W, 28.4' dist mkd 1/4 S22 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 & painted face of blaze & a 6' band of red around each bearing tree.

Compass declination 19° East.
