
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Henry Meldrum under GLO Contract no. 450 dated June 11, 1882, and his record states:

Set post 3 ft long 3 ins diam 24 ins in ground for 1/4 Sec. Cor marked 1/4 S on W face. From which:

A fir 18 ins diam bears  $N80^{\circ}$ E, 28 lks dist marked 1/4 S. B. T. A fir 18 ins diam bears  $N78^{\circ}$ W, 16 lks dist marked 1/4 S. B. T.



## Description of corner evidence found:

None. Corner reestablished by proportionate measurement from survey control.

Corner position obliterated by Forest Service logging and road construction operations.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position midway between adjacent section corners north and south...

Set a 2" x 30" aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 24" in ground & projecting 6" out of ground with surrounding stone mound & placed 6' steel fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: Spruce 16" dia brs S86½°E, 78.8' dist mkd 1/4S24 BT. Spruce 16" dia brs S18°W, 38.4' dist mkd 1/4S23 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" band of red around each bearing tree.

Compass declination 190 East.
