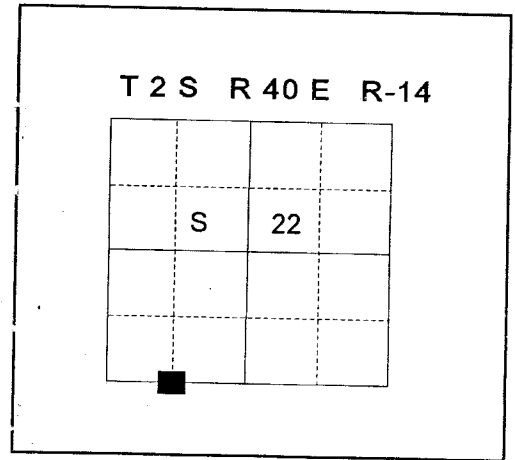


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:
Corner not previously established.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Corner not previously established.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by said survey, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 20" in the ground, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8"x30" iron pin with aluminum cap marked S22 RP bears N 61°E, a distance of 8.75 feet in small mound of stone.

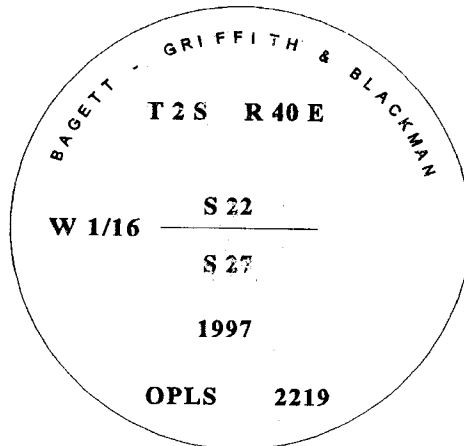
A 5/8"x30" iron pin with aluminum cap marked S27 RP bears S 53°E, a distance of 12.15 feet in small mound of stone.

Raised a mound of stone around monument, 3 ft. Base to top of cap. Set steel fence post approximately 2 feet South of monument.
