Set post 3 ft long 3 ins square 24 ins in ground for 1/4 Sec. Cor. marked 1/4S on N face. From which:

A fir 8 ins diam bears S52°W,9 lks dist marked 1/4 S.B.T. A pine 4 ins diam bears N33°E, 49 lks dist marked 1/4 S.B.T.

Description of corner evidence found:

None. Corner reestablished by proportionate measurement from survey control.

Corner search area is in area of old wildfire and recent logging forested predominantly with lodgepole pine and alder brush - there are also many sawed stumps and uproots from logging machinery.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position midway between adjacent section corner East and West...

Set a 2" x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 25" in ground & projecting 5" out of ground with surrounding earth mound & placed 6' steel fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. No stones available for mound.

New bearing trees established: White fir 13" diam brs N49 $^{10}_{4}$ W, 31.3' mkd 1/4S23 BT. Douglas fir 17" diam brs S60 W, 39.9' mkd 1/4S26 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" band of red around each bearing tree.

Compass declination 190 East.
