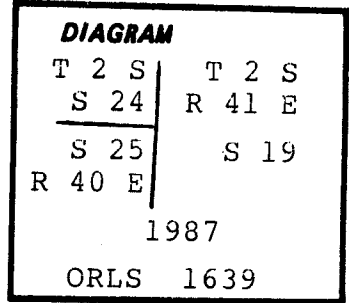


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract No. 450 and dated June 11, 1882. Surveyor General records state: Set post 4 ft long 4 ins square 24 ins in ground for Cor to Secs 24, 25, 19 & 34 mkd T2SR40ES24 on NW, R40ES25 on SW, R41ES30 on SE and S19 on NE with 2 notches on S and 4 on N edge from which: A fir 12" dia brs N43°E, 58 lks dist mkd S19 BT. A tamarack 30" dia brs N56°W, 50 lks dist mkd T2SS24 BT. A tamarack 16" dia brs S45°W, 61 lks dist mkd R40ES25 BT. A tamarack 9" dia brs S68°E, 17 lks dist mkd R41ES30 BT.

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Corner MODIFIED by Alonzo Gesner under GLO contract No. 683 dated June 17, 1898, and his records state: The Cor to Secs 24 and 25 which is a post marked and witnessed as stated by the U.S. Survey General I destroyed the marks on the NE and SE faces of post and obliterated marks on the bearing trees in Secs 19 and 20.

Description of corner evidence found:

No trace of original post corner.

A rotten tamarack stump with burned face mkd R40ES25 BT, on double blaze alongside brs S44°W, 61 lks dist per record. A green tamarack 40" dia with healed double blaze and ancient axe marks on bark brs N52°W (record, N56°W), 50 lks dist. No trace of other two BTs obliterated by Alonzo Gesner in 1898.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position established by record distance intersection from found original BT's...

Set 2½" aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 20" in ground & 10" projecting out of ground with surrounding earth mound & 6' fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established:

A 8" alpine fir brs S64°W, 18.3' dist mkd T2SR40ES25 BT.

Each BT has a sign 54-3 and signs 54-4 or 54-9 attached below a 6" band of red paint, and each new BT has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.

Compass declination 17° East.

I hereby certify that the above described corner monument was properly remonumented by me and witnessed by Jim DeMastus on August 10, 1987.
