
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Henry Meldrum under GLO Contract no. 450 dated June 11, 1882, and his record states:

Set post 3 ft long 3 ins square 24 ins in ground for 1/4 Sec. Corner marked 1/4 S on N face. From which:

A pine 7 ins diam bears S23°E, 24 lks dist marked 1/4 S. B. T. A pine 12 ins diam bears S82°W, 52 lks dist marked 1/4 S. B. T.



Description of corner evidence found:

None. Corner reestablished by proportionate measurement from survey control. Corner position is in old burn area.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position midway between adjacent section corners north and south...

Set a 2" x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 24" in ground & projecting 6" out of ground with surrounding stone mound & placed 6' steel fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: Lodgepole pine 9" dia brs $N80^{\circ}E$, 9.2' dist mkd 1/4 S25 BT. Lodgepole pine 11" dia brs $S39\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$, 35.1' dist mkd 1/4 S26 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" band of red around each bearing tree.

Compass declination 190 East.
