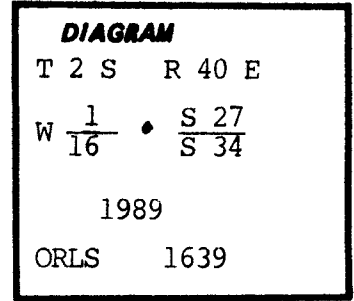


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

None. Corner established with this survey.



Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position midway between adjacent section corner W & adjacent 1/4 corner E...
Set a 2" x 30" aluminum pipe with 2½" aluminum cap 24" in ground & projecting 6" out of ground with surrounding stone mound & placed 6' steel fence post alongside with signs 54-2 & 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

There being no trees available, the following bearing objects were established...
A lava rock outcrop 6' x 6' projecting 4' out of ground brs S07°W, 78.1' dist mkd B X O.
A basalt boulder 36" x 28" projecting 8" out of ground brs N27½°E, 47.0' dist mkd B X O. Bearing objects are painted red.
Compass declination 19° East.
