Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 4" diam round wood post 30" long blazed on one face and faintly scribed 1/4 S lying in rock mound at foot of 15' high rock outcrop. This recovered wood post is lichen covered & heavily weather checked & accepted as original corner post.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of rotten wood remains in center of rock mound...

Set a 2" x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 24" in ground & projecting 6" out of ground with surrounding stone mound & placed 6' steel fence post alongside with signs 54-2 & 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Original corner post painted red and placed alongside surrounding rock mound.

There being no trees available, the following bearing objects were established:

The face of a large basalt outcrop 15' high brs N26°W, 2.8' dist mkd B X O. A basalt rock outcrop 24" x 14" projecting 48" out of ground brs S70°E, 1.5' dist mkd B X O. Bearing objects painted with red paint.

Compass declination 190 East.
