Description of corner evidence found:

Corner reestablished by proportionate measurement from survey control. Corner position has been burned many years ago.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position midway between adjacent section corners East & West...

Set a 2" x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 24" in ground & projecting 6" out of ground with surrounding earth mound & placed 6' steel fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. No stones available for mound.

New bearing trees established: Spruce 12" dia brs $S40\frac{1}{6}$ E, 16.0' dist mkd 1/4 S36 BT. Spruce 12" dia brs N23°E, 53.5' dist mkd 1/4 S25 BT.
