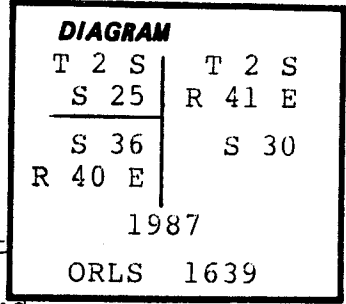


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

V-25

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract No. 450 and dated June 11, 1882. Surveyor General records state: Set post 4' long 4" square 24" in ground for Cor to Secs 25, 36, 30 & 31 mkd T2SR40ES25 on NW, S30 on NE, R41ES31 on SE and R40ES36 on SW with 1 notch on S and 5 notches on N edge from which: A pine 16" dia brs N35°E, 35 lks dist mkd S30 BT. A pine 20" dia brs N36°W, 56 lks dist mkd T2SR40ES25 BT. A pine 10" dia brs S5°W, 45 lks dist mkd R40ES36 BT. A fir 24" dia brs S10°E, 17 lks dist mkd R41ES31 BT.



Corner reestablished by Alonzo Gesner under GLO contract No. 683 dated June 7, 1898. His records state: Cor to Secs 25 & 36 T2SR40E, which had been destroyed which I reestablished... Set basalt stone 18 x 8 x 7 in 12 ins in ground mkd with 1 notch on S & 5 notches on the N sides from which: A tamarack 14" dia brs N31°30'W, 191 lks dist mkd T2SR40ES25 BT. No other trees in limits or convenient to mark in Sec 36. Raised mound of stone 3' base 2½' high 10 lks West of corner.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a stone 18 x 7 x 5" (record, 18 x 8 x 7") no marks positively identified, 10 lks east of remnants of man-made rock mound from which:

A tamarack windblow 15" dia and root stub mkd with fragmentary scribes on open & rotting blaze brs N31½°W, 191 lks per record. No other tree found by Gesner.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of record sized stone...

Set 2½" aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 25" in ground & 5" projecting out of ground with surrounding rock mound & 6' fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Buried stone alongside. REMARKS: This corner is on top edge of vertical rocky bluff 30' high.

New bearing trees established:

A tamarack 11" dia brs S05½°W, 43.4' dist mkd T2SR40ES36 BT.
A tamarack 11" dia brs N46½°W, 41.8' dist mkd T2SR40ES25 BT.

Each BT has a sign 54-3 and signs 54-4 or 54-9 attached below a 6" band of red paint, and each new BT has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.

Compass declination 17° East.
