
History of original corner establishment:

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a rotten root stub with rotten tree alongside mkd 1/4S28 on wood fragment from which:

A L.P. pine windblow 12" dia & root stub brs N64°W, 21.0'(record, N69°W, 39 lks) marked 1/4S29 BT on open double blaze. A rotten A L.P. pine windblow & root hole brs N38°E, 17.0'(record, N39°E, 27

lks) with fragmentary scribes on rotten wood.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of rotten root stub...

Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 25" in ground with 5" projecting out of ground with surrounding rock mound and 6' fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: A alpine fir 6" dia brs $$S43\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$$, 11.3' dist mkd 1/4S28 BT. A alpine fir 10" dia brs $$S57^{\circ}W$$, 32.3' dist mkd 1/4S29 BT.

Each BT has a sign 54-3 and signs 54-4 or 54-9 attached below a 6" band of red paint, and each new BT has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.

Compass declination 190 East.
