

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

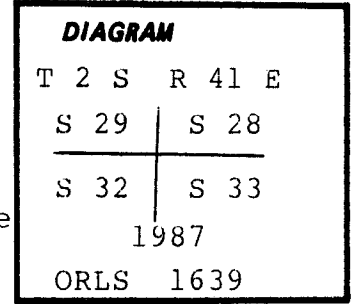
History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Alonzo Gesner under GLO contract No. 683 and dated June 7, 1898.

Surveyor General records state: Set fir post 4' long 4" square 24" in ground for Cor to Secs 28,29,32 & 33 mkd T2SS28 on NE, R41SS33 on SE, S32 on SW and S29 on NW with 1 notch on the S and 4 notches on the E edges from which:

- A 14" black pine brs N15°E, 37 lks dist mkd T2SR41ES-28 BT.
- A 8" fir brs S68°30'E, 33 lks dist mkd T2SR41ES33 BT.
- A 20" spruce brs S11°45'W, 22 lks dist mkd T2SR41ES32 BT.
- A 7" black pine brs N36°30'W, 34 lks dist mkd T2SR41ES29 BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found rotten remains of wood post to a depth of 12" from which: Rotten tree remains and root hole brs N14°E, 23.8'(record, N15°E, 37 lks). A alpine fir 16" dia brs S72°E, 21.8'(record, S68°30'E, 33 lks) with fragmentary scribes on a partially healed blaze. A spruce 29" dia brs S08°W, 14.5'(record, S11°45'W, 22 lks) with fragmentary scribes on a partially healed blaze. A L.P. pine 12" dia brs N38°W, 22.5'(record N36°30'W, 34 lks) with full scribes on a partially healed blaze.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of original wood post...
 Set 2½" aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 25" in ground with 5" projecting out of ground with surrounding earth mound and 6' fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.
 New bearing tree established:
 A alpine fir 10" dia brs N50½°E, 23.8' dist mkd T2SR41ES28 BT.
 Each BT has a sign 54-3 and signs 54-4 or 54-9 attached below a 6" band of red paint, and each new BT has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.
 Compass declination 19° East.
