

Dependent Recovery of East of S. Boundary

2.05 The closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3; which is a basalt stone, 18x8x7 ins., firmly set, marked with 2 grooves on E., 6 grooves on S., and 4 grooves on W. face:

At point for cor:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with the original stone deposited at the base, for closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap marked

A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears S.13°W., 60 lks. dist., marks grown over. (Old B. T.)

Desc. 280 ft. over SW. slope.

12.10 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course S.10°E.; asc. 606 ft. over E. slope.

31.10 Spur, slopes SE.; desc. 99 ft. over SW. slope.

39.42 Proportionate measurement.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, for cor. of secs. 34 and 35 only, with brass cap marked
