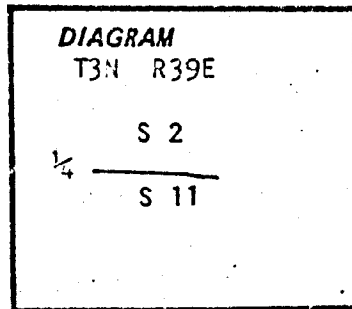


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

E-19

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was established by Frank W. Campbell in 1884 under GLO Contract No. 498, dated May 10, 1884. Surveyor General Record States:



Set post for 1/4 section corner from which:

- A fir 8" diameter bears N 22 links
A tamarack 20" diameter bears S 6° W, 25 links

No record of subsequent remonumentation found in county records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found SW BT--Found no evidence of other BT

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

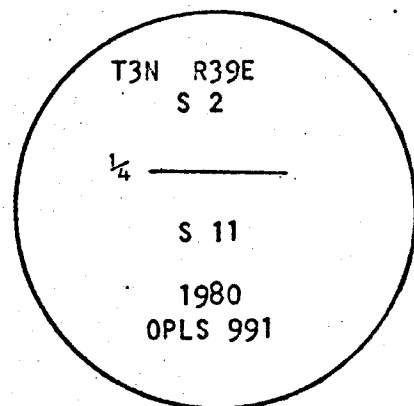
At record Bearing and distance from BT I set 2 1/2" x 30" iron pipe with brass cap marked as shown 26" in ground, from which:

Original BT

A 20" tamarack, dead and down bears S6°W, 16.5 ft, scribes visible

New BTs

- A 15" white fir bears N 88° E, 28.6 ft, marked 1/4 S2 BT
A 13" tamarack bears S 40° E, 42.1 ft, marked 1/4 S11 BT
