

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a $5/8" \times 30"$ iron pin, 30 inches in the ground, with $2 \frac{1}{2}"$ aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

An 8 inch Douglas Fir bears South 73° West, a distance of 95.30 feet, marked NE 1/16 S13 BT. An 8 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North 23° West, a distance of 95.10 feet, marked NE 1/16 S13 BT.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 1 ft. North of corner monument.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the accessories. Magnetic declination used was 16° East. Distances are to a 60d spike in the right hand side of the root crown of the trees. Bearings are to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the BT blaze of the tree.
