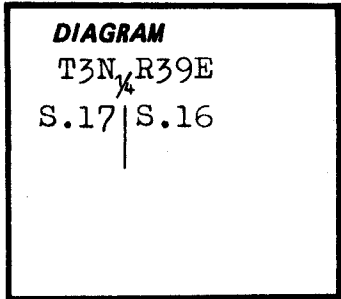


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

L-9

History of original corner establishment:

Corner monumented by F. W. Campbell in 1884 under contract No. 498, set a 10" X 8" X 8" basalt stone 8" in the ground, marked ¼ on West face. 6" diam. Spruce, East, 19 links, mkd. ¼SBT. 11" Diam. Spruce, S. 70° W., 21 links, mkd. ¼SBT.



Description of corner evidence found:

10" X 8" X 8" stone with ¼ scribe on West face, set firmly in place. Stump hole, East, 19 links. Stump hole, S. 70° W., 21 links.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2½" Diam. brass cap in a 2" X 30" iron pipe at the Corner and buried Cornerstone alongside pipe.

14" D.B.H. Douglas Fir, S.5° W., 22.4', scribed ¼S17BT.

12" D.B.H. Tamarack, S. 72° E., 15.0', scribed ¼S16BT.

Both B.T.'s. have brass washers marked RPLS 1910 between B&T, attention signs, B.T. tags, and red painted bands.

Steel fence post 4.0' North and South of Corner with attention, monument and property signs attached.
