

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, with a 2 ½" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 30 inches in the ground, from which:


A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears North 29° East, a distance of 50.33 feet, with a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked NERP. Pin falls on the West side of a railroad tie fence corner. A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears South 61° East, a distance of 26.88 feet, with a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked SERP. Pin falls on the Westerly side of an North/South running fenceline.

I set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot North of corner monument. I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on September 24, 2013.
