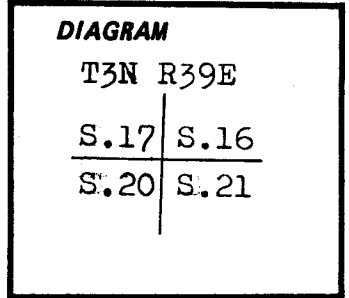


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

N-9

History of original corner establishment:

Corner monumented by F.W. Campbell in 1884 under contract No. 498, remonumented in 1978 by Wayne O. Harris on C.S.#N-9, G.L.O. records show A Stone, 10"X10"X6", 7" in the ground, with 3 notches on South and 4 notches on East edges.
 Fir 27" diam., S.74°E., 67 links mkd T3NR39ES21BT
 Fir 12" diam., S.6°W., 67 links, mkd. T3NR39ES20BT
 Pine 12" diam., N.14°W., 200 links, mkd. T3NR39ES17BT
 Cherry 8" diam., N.70°E., 116 links, mkd., T3NR39ES16BT



Description of corner evidence found:

Stone in rock pile around monument set on C.S.#N-9 with "X" on top, 3 notches on South face and 4 notches on East face, moss on side of stone indicated it had been out of the ground and laying on its side many years. Ponderose Pine, 24"D.B.H., (12") N.14°W., 200 links, with scribe visible on face I opened.
 45" D.B.H. Douglas Fir, (27") now a snag, S.74°E., 67 links, with scribes R39E S21 visible.
 No mention of Pine B.T. or Stone on C.S.#N-9.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2½" Diam. brass cap in a 2"X30" iron pipe at the intersection of the record distances from the two remaining B.T's. Cap Stamped T3N R39E
 The following references are to B.T's. Scribed on C.S.#N-9, not by me.

16" D.B.H. White Fir, S.81°W., 39.7', scribed T3NR39ES17BT
 10" D.B.H. White Fir, S.21°W., 23.4', scribed T3NR39ES20BT
 12" D.B.H. White Fir, S.38°E., 32.8', scribed T3NR39ES21BT
 8" D.B.H. White Fir, N.87°E., 15.0' scribed face partially healed, 1982
 all B.T's. have B.T. tags, attention signs, and red painted bands
 Steel fence posts 4.0'± North and East with attention, monument and boundary signs.

The brass capped iron pipe set by Wayne O Harris, which I rejected as being out of position, bears S. 3° 47' 35" W., 6.99' from the corner point I have monumented.

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

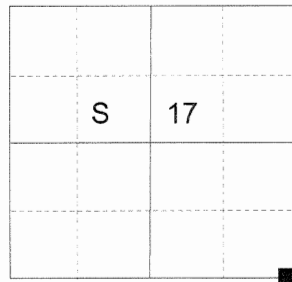
Original corner set by Herman D. Gradon, under GLO contract No. 517, dated September 30, 1884. Surveyor General Record States:

Set Basalt Stone 10 x 8 x 6, 7 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 16, 17, 20, and 21 marked with 3 notches on S and 4 notches on E edges,

From which:

- A fir 6 ins. in diam. bears N13°E 32 lks. dist. marked T3NR40ES16 BT.
- A fir 10 ins. in diam. bears S40°E 19 lks. dist. marked T3NR40ES21 BT.
- A pine 30 ins. in diam. bears S60°W 68 lks. dist. marked T3NR40ES20 BT.
- A fir 10 ins. in diam. bears N56°W 69 lks. dist. marked T3NR40ES17 BT.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found
A 35" x 15' down and decaying log with "T3N R40E S20 BT" scribes visible (South West BT). No sign of other bearing trees.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At record distance and bearing from stump hole of found South West bearing tree I set a 30" x 2 1/2" aluminum pipe with 3" aluminum cap marked as shown, 28" in the ground,

From which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

- A 10" Douglas Fir bears North 39° East, a distance of 18.35 feet, marked T3NR40ES16 BT.
- A 14" Ponderosa Pine bears South 69° East, a distance of 9.95 feet, marked T3NR40ES21 BT.
- A 9" Douglas Fir bears South 64° West, a distance of 9.75 feet, marked T3NR40ES20 BT.
- An 11" Douglas Fir bears North 26° West, a distance of 30.00 feet, marked T3NR40ES17 BT.

Set steel fence post approx. 1 ft. West of monument.

Corner falls just off top edge of North/South running ridge on East face.

I hereby certify that the corner was perpetuated December 13, 2017.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the bearing trees and objects. Magnetic declination used was 13° East. Bearing is to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the lower blaze of the trees. Distance is to a spike set in the root crown of the side of the trees.
