HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Corner established by Frank W. Campbell under GLO Contract Number 498, dated March 10th, 1884. Surveyor General Field Notes state:

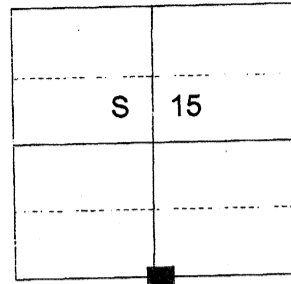
Set a pine post 3 ft long 3 ins square 24 ins in the ground for 1/4 sec corner marked 1/4 S on N face

from which:

A fir 6 ins diam bears S6°W 28 lks dist marked 1/4 S B.T

A fir 6 ins diam bears N20°W 40 lks dist marked 1/4 S B.T

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

None. Area has been historically logged extensively.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At proportionate position, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe, 26" in the ground, with 3" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

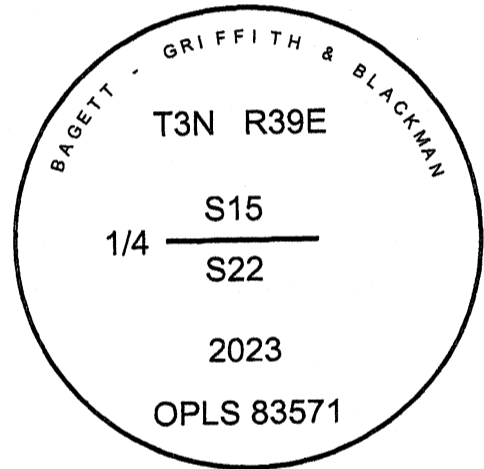
A 16" diam. Ponderosa Pine bears North 74° East, a dist. of 12.20 feet, marked 1/4 S15 BT

A 14" diam. Ponderosa Pine bears South 42° East, a dist. of 11.10 feet, marked 1/4 S22 BT

A 14" diam. Ponderosa Pine bears South 74° West, a dist. of 6.10 feet, marked 1/4 S22 BT

A 12" diam. Western Larch bears North 17° West, a dist. of 15.90 feet, marked 1/4 S15 BT

Set steel fence post approx. 1 foot West
