

# DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

#### TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with 2 ½" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 30 inches in the ground, from which:

# NEW BEARING TREES:

A 9" Ponderosa Pine bears South 69° East, a distance of 24.40 feet, marked CS 1/16 S23 BT. A 9" Douglas Fir bears North 36° West, a distance of 19.95 feet, marked CS 1/16 S23 BT.

I hereby certify that this monument was set November 29, 2016. Corner falls on N side of a logging road approx. 24 feet South of an East/West running fenceline. A fence corner bears North 46° East, 25 feet. Set a steel fencepost approx. 3 ft. North of corner monument.
