

## NEW BEARING TREES:


A 7" diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S 2° W, a distance of 6.15 feet, marked X BT.

I used 18° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the new bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 2219 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
