

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with 2 ½" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 28 inches in the ground, from which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

An 8" Ponderosa Pine bears North 63° East, a distance of 25.05 feet, marked N1/16 S26 BT. An 11" Ponderosa Pine bears North 14° West, a distance of 34.85 feet, marked N1/16 S27 BT.


Set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot North of the corner monument. Corner approximately 11 feet NE of a fence corner.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the bearing trees. Magnetic declination used was 15° East. Bearings are to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the lower BT blaze. Distances are to at 60d spike in the right hand side of the tree.
