

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with 2 ½" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 30 inches in the ground, from which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

A 9" Douglas Fir bears South 60° East, a distance of 30.35 feet, marked S 1/16 S26 BT. A 9" Ponderosa Pine bears North 86° West, a distance of 69.95 feet, marked S 1/16 S27 BT.

Corner falls approximately 25 feet East of a fence corner.



I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the bearing trees. Magnetic declination used was 15° East. Bearings are to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the lower BT blaze. Distances are to at 60d spike in the right hand side of the tree.
