


# TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At proportionate position, I set a 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 27 inches in the ground, in a collar of stone 1 ft. diam., from which:

#### NEW BEARING TREES:


A 7" White Fir bears North 37° East, a distance of 9.95 feet, marked 1/4 S27 BT. A 12" Douglas Fir bears South 80° East, a distance of 17.20 feet, marked 1/4 S34 BT. A 10" White Fir bears South 80° West, a distance of 16.85 feet, marked 1/4 S34 BT. An 11" Spruce bears North 63° West, a distance of 47.95 feet, marked 1/4 S27 BT.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot North of corner monument. I hereby certify that the corner was monumented November 11, 2015.
