

At position determined by survey, I set a $5/8" \times 30"$ iron pin with 2 ½" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 26 inches in the ground, from which:

NEW BEARING TREES:


A 7" Ponderosa Pine bears North 25° East, a distance of 18.75 feet, marked CN 1/16 S34 BT. A 6" Ponderosa Pine bears South 79° West, a distance of 1.80 feet, marked CN 1/16 S34 BT.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot North of corner. I hereby certify that the corner was monumented November 10, 2015.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the bearing trees. Magnetic declination used was 15° East. Bearings are to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the lower BT blaze. Distances are to at 60d spike in the right hand side of the tree.
