

## DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

#### TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with 2 ½" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 28 inches in the ground, from which:

#### NEW BEARING TREES:

A 17 inch Ponderosa Pine bears South 43° East, a distance of 23.60 feet, marked CE 1/16 S34 BT.

A 7 inch Douglas Fir bears South 34° West, a distance of 7.00 feet, marked CE 1/16 S34 BT.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 0.5 feet North of corner monument. Corner falls on the South bank of a creek.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented December 14, 2015.



I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the bearing trees. Magnetic declination used was 15° East. Bearings are to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the lower BT blaze. Distances are to at 60d spike in the right hand side of the tree.
