

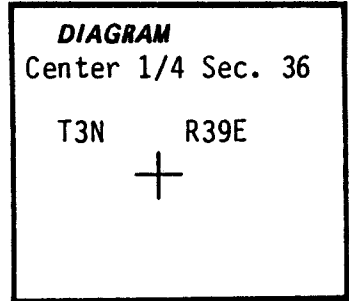
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

X-23

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was not established during the original survey. The legal description and plat of survey for County Road Petition No. 667 (now known as Cabin Creek Co. Rd. No. 140) dated 1916, states:

Beginning at the center post on the West side of Sec. 36, T3N, R39E, W.M.,..., thence due East to center said Section 36, thence due North ..."



Description of corner evidence found:

No physical evidence of a corner monument was found.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

In our opinion, the location of the center 1/4 corner of Section 36, T3N,R39E, as determined by the survey for County Road Petition 667 has been perpetuated and can be restored by reference to the existing roadway. We therefore establish the corner point at the intersection of the center of the fenced right-of-ways of Cabin Creek County Road running Northerly and Westerly from the corner point.

At the corner point, we set a 5/8"x30" Iron Rod, buried 6", with yellow plastic cap attached, marked "AP&A" and establish the following bearing objects:

- A 5/8"x30" Iron Rod with yellow plastic cap attached, marked "AP&A", set along an existing E-W fenceline bears S60°E 42.54 feet,
- And a 5/8"x30" Iron Rod with yellow plastic cap attached, marked "AP&A", set along an existing E-W fence line, bears S49°W 36.69 feet.

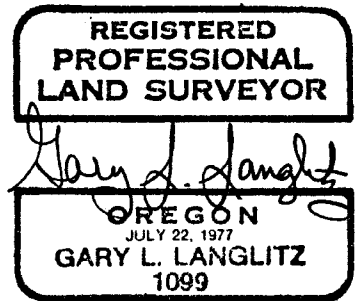
