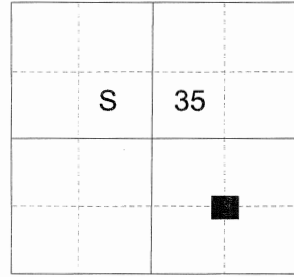

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8"x30" iron pin, 26" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears North 42°21' East, a distance of 13.86 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked N RP.

A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears South 19°30' East, a distance of 13.90 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked S RP.

Set a steel fencepost approx. 0.5 ft. North of monument.
