

# DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position by survey I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 27" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below and in a 1.5 ft. diam. collar of stone, From which:

### NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5" Douglas Fir bears North 66° East a dist. of 21.05 ft., marked CW 1/16 S20 BT. A 6" Douglas Fir bears South 4° West a dist. of 48.75 ft., marked CW 1/16 S20 BT.

Set steel fence post bears South approx. 1'

A remnant of a rock jack fence corner to West and South bearing fence lines bears North  $46^{\circ}$  West a dist. of 44 ft.
