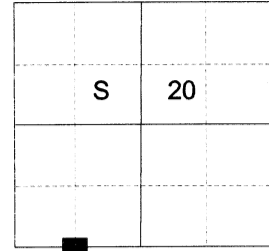

At position by survey I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 28" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below and in a 2 ft. diam. collar of stone,  
From which:

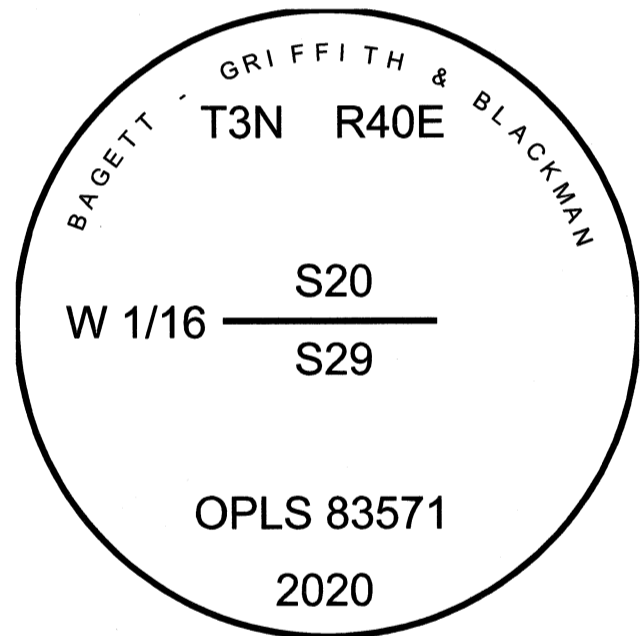
**NEW BEARING OBJECTS:**

An 11" Ponderosa Pine bears North 7° East a dist. of 50.50 ft., marked W 1/16 S20 BT.  
A 16" Ponderosa Pine bears South 66° West a dist. of 7.40 ft., marked W 1/16 S29 BT.

Set steel fence post bears North approx. 1'

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on October 20, 2020.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 14° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
