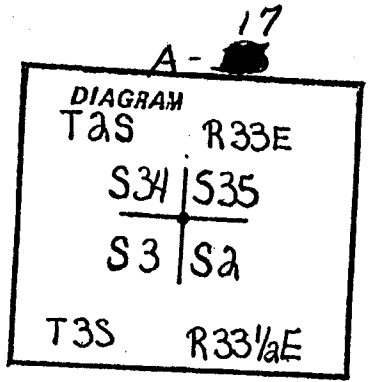


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The exterior lines of township 3 South Range 33½ East were originally established by Rufus L. Moore under Contract No. 451, dated June 12, 1882. The original notes state that at the corner a 4 ft. long by 4 inch square post was set 24 inches in the ground from which:

- A 10" pine bears N 35°E 33 LK (21.8 ft) marked T 25, R 33½E S35BT
- A 24" tamarack bears S 40°W 6 LK (4.0 ft.) marked T35 R 33½E S3BT
- A 36" pine bears S 73°E 12 LK (7.9 ft.) marked T3S R 33½E S2BT
- A 8" fir bears N31°W 22 LK (14.5 ft.) marked T2S R 33½E S34BT



No record of subsequent re-monumentation found in County records.

Description of corner evidence found:

- Found no evidence of original monument, set from 3 original Bt's by the average distance intersection.
- A 22½" tamarack bears S48°W 5.0' to center of tree, open blaze scribing visible, dying.
- A 40" red fir bears S 75°E 9.5 ft to center of tree with blaze healed, dead.
- A 8" douglas fir bears N 31°W 14.0 ft to center of tree with healed blaze, dead.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

- At the corner position a 2 inch by 30 inch iron pipe, with brass cap marked as shown, was set 24 inches in ground and surrounded with a mound of stones.
- Set a steel fence post on Township line W of corner and attached signs 54-2 and 54-4.
- Established 4 new BT's: A 14" tamarack bears S60°E 23.9 ft, scribed T3S R33½E S2 BT
- A 18" fir bears S14°W 34.5 ft, scribed T3S R33½E S3 BT.
- A 9-3/4" fir bears N57½°E 26.5 ft, scribed T2S R33E S35 BT.
- A 12½" fir bears N23°W 15.1 ft, scribed T2S R33E S34 BT.
- New BTS have a lower blaze scribed BT with brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush.
- Attached sign 54-3 and 54-4 and painted red ring around all BT's.

Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 19½° east variation. Measured to center of BT's.

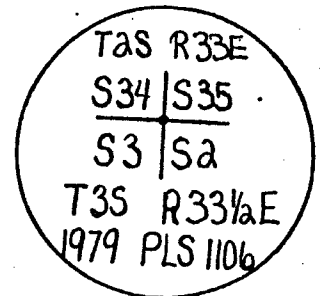
