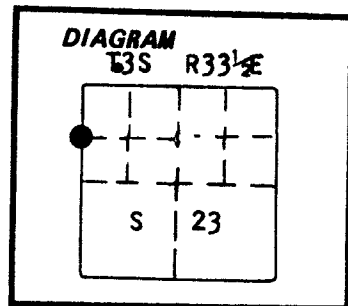


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: At the position determined by survey, I set a 2 1/2"x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown below, 28" in the ground with a surrounding ring of stones, from which:

A 5/8"x30" rebar with a plastic cap marked BGA Survey Marker, bears N 51° E 22.40 feet.

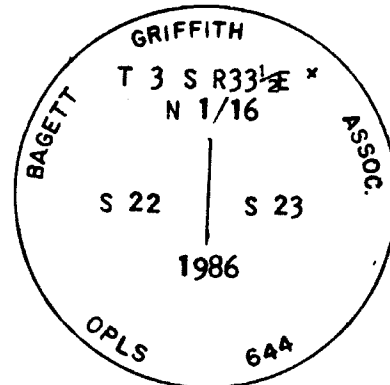
A 5/8"x30" rebar with a plastic cap marked BGA Survey Marker, bears N 54° W, 10.14 feet.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet North with a 54-2 and a 54-9 sign attached.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet East with a 54-2 sign attached.

Brass washer marked OPLS 644 nailed to BT blaze. Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 20° East declination. Distances to the BTs are to a 50d spike set in right side of tree when facing tree, unless otherwise stated.
