
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner established by Rufus S. Moore under General Land Office contract number 451, dated June 12, 1882. Surveyor General record state:

Set pine post 3 feet long 3 ins square 18^{11} in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec cor marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W face from which:

A tamarack 10" diameter bears N26°E 10 1ks dist marked $\mbox{1}\mbox{2}\mbox{3



No record of subsequent remonumentation found in county records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found 10" tamarack, rotted, dead and down, with scribes visible Found root hole at record position for Southwest BT


