

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

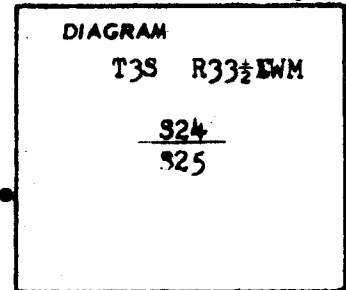
Corner established by General Land Office contract survey.

The original notes state;

Ran west between sections 24 and 25. 39.94 ch. set basalt stone 19x18x8", 7" in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ corner marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on north face from which;

Pine 20" in dia bears N19°E 8 lks dist marked $\frac{1}{4}$ SBT;

Pine 10" in dia bears S8°E 23 lks dist marked $\frac{1}{4}$ SBT;



Description of corner evidence found:

Found stone marked $\frac{1}{4}$
In section 25 found 24" down log.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position of the corner I set a 30" galvanized pipe with an eight inch plate welded to bottom and a bronze cap on top. The hole was back filled with stone and tamped soil.

From the monument the original bearing trees are (none) ;

I established the following new bearing trees;

A red fir 7" dia bears N45°W at a distance of 11.1 ft and scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ SBT;

A lodge pole pine 8" in dia bears S64°E at a distance of 13.2 ft and scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ SBT;

The distance measured to center of respective trees on level.

I placed bearing tree signs on both old and new bearing trees and

attached near the corner.
