
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

A 5/8"x30" iron pin with plastic cap marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER" set by said Partition, bears South 0°12'11" West, a distance of 66.07 ft.

A 5/8"x30" iron pin with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked "W RP" bears N 50°42"W, a distance of 19.35 ft. (Pin is set in an existing North-South fence line).
