## History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established by Rufus S, Moore, under GLO contract No. 451, during November, 1881. Surveyor General's notes state: "Set a basalt stone 18 X 12 X 6 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 on N. face. From which: A pine 16 ins. in diam. bears N28°W, 39 lks. dist. marked 1/4S BT. A pine 16 ins. in diam. bears S06°E, 72 lks. dist. marked 1/4S BT."

## Description of corner evidence found:

Corner falls in center of an old road and no trace of record stone could be found. Found 30" pine, partially opened blaze, "45" visible. Measured S28°E, 25.7 ft. and found 45" pine with grown over blazes that bears S06°E, 47.8 ft.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the above point set 2 1/2" X 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 12" in the ground to bedrock and mound of stone around to cap,
Placed 54-3s and 54-4s on the BTs. Painted 6" red band around. Placed 54-2 and 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' west of the corner.
