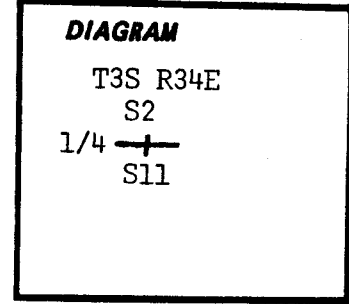


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index File No. E-19

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established by Rufus S. Moore, under GLO contract No. 451, during November, 1882. Surveyor General's notes state: "Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 S on N. face, from which: A pine 40 ins. in dia. bears S35°W, 19 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S BT, A pine 3 ins. in dia. bears N1°W, 13 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S BT."




Description of corner evidence found:

Corner falls on a flat bench in thick lodgepole pine. Several hours were spent searching for the corner. No large pines were found in the area of the corner. Every large pine within 300 ft. of the corner was checked with no results.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

After a diligent search, at the surveyed point set 2 1/2" X 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked; Set pipe 25" in the ground and small mound of stone around to cap, From which by magnetic declination of N20°E;
A 9" lodgepole pine bears S77°E, 75.0 ft. scribed 1/4 S11 BT. An 8" fir bears N23°W, 28.2 ft. scribed 1/4 S2 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s, 54-4s, and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on the BTs. Placed 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' west of the corner.
