Description of corner evidence found:

Found no trace of record stone. Found small mound of stone from which an 18" rotten pine stump bears S80°E, 125.0 ft. A down and rotten 24" pine, stump hole, bears N63°W, 103.2 ft.

Corner falls about 10' east of N-S fence.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the above point set 2 1/2" X 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 12" in the ground and mound of stone around to cap. From which by magnetic declination of N20°E;

A 14" pine bears N39°E, 76.1 ft. scribed 1/4S13 BT. A 15" pine bears N66°W, 139.6 ft. scribed 1/4S14 BT. Placed 54-3s on old BTs. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s, 54-4s and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Placed 54-2 and 54-4 on steel fence post 5' north of the corner.
