
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index File No. X-21

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established by Rufus S. Moore under GLO contract No. 451 during November, 1881, Surveyor's General's notes state: "set a post 3 ft, long 3 ins, in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor, marked 1/4S on W, face. From which: A pine 15 ins. diam. bears S47°W, 19 1ks. dist. marked 1/4S BT. A pine 15 ins. diam. bears S39°E, 28 1ks. dist. marked 1/4S BT."



Description of corner evidence found:

Found no trace of record post, Found a 24" pine with grown over blaze and old location tag. Measured N47°W, 14.0 ft. and at S39°E, 18.0 ft. found 12" stump, rotten pine.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At above point set 2 1/2" X 30" galyanized pipe and brass cap marked; Set pipe 22" in the ground and mound of stone around to cap,

From which by magnetic declination of N2Q°E; A 26" pine

bears S61°E, 139.7 ft. scribed 1/4S36 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3, 54-4 and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Old BTs are signed. Placed 54-2 and 54-4 on steel fence post 5' north of the corner.
